

## Training Resource Package (TRP) Task Team Terms of Reference

The IBP Consortium engages member organizations and the broader reproductive health and family planning (FP/RH) community to identify, implement, and scale up effective practices. One of the core objectives of the IBP 2011-2016 Strategic Plan is *to enhance knowledge sharing that improves access to, and application of, information and resources*. The IBP Results Framework seeks to increase advocacy for utilization of FP/RH EPs; increase country-level participation in FP/RH BP activities; and increase identification of priority effective practices (EPs) at the country level. IBP has committed to promote the dissemination and implementation of the Training Resource Package (TRP) and to that end, the consortium is convening a TRP Task Team to develop mechanisms and strategies to disseminate, implement and support scale up of and share lessons learned about this important resource.

### **The IBP Secretariat, in collaboration with Pathfinder is convening a TRP Task Team to perform the following functions:**

- Develop a strategy and plan to support dissemination and implementation of the TRP at regional and country levels
- Provide overall vision and guidance to the IBP consortium on support for dissemination of TRP materials and for its implementation, including TA on institutionalization and local ownership of dissemination channels and TRP materials into local health systems
- Evaluate training materials, including website, to strengthen implementation
- Document implementation of TRP and capture lessons learned on adaptation in diverse contexts
- Develop information for the TRP website
- Track progress and identify solutions to challenges in dissemination and implementation of the TRP
- Report progress and results to IBP consortium via Knowledge Gateway and IBP meetings

### **About the Training Resource Package**

The Training Resource Package for Family Planning (TRP) is a comprehensive set of materials designed to support up-to-date training on family planning and reproductive health. The TRP was developed using evidence-based technical information from World Health Organization (WHO) publications and it contains curriculum components and tools needed to design, implement, and evaluate training. It provides organizations with the essential resource for family planning (FP) and reproductive health trainers, supervisors, and program managers.
